

Matt Rage is a guitarist/vocalist from the North Florida area. Having grown up listening to rock, country, and blues, he has a wealth and breadth of influences to draw on. Despite having begun to learn to play guitar at the age of 12, by the age of 14, he was already fronting working bands with professional sidemen 10 or more years his senior in club and festival venues, even winning several "battle of the bands" contests with his "Matt Rage Band."
